Dear Parents and Guardians of Children Wishing to Prepare for Confirmation
in 2018-2019:

A FEW DETAILS REGARDING CONFIRMATION

The celebration of Confirmation usually happens when children are in grade 6. In September you will be receiving a Registration Form if you would like your child to be prepared for this Sacrament. Preparation happens in many ways: teachers, parents and the parish community work together to help prepare your child for this happy occasion.

There are some steps you can take before September to plan for this special day:

If your child was baptized in a Catholic Church you will be asked for a copy of the baptismal certificate when you register for the Sacraments in the fall – this is a good time to start looking for it! If you need contact information for the church where your child was baptized please call the Parish Office and we will be happy to help. Your child should also have celebrated 1st Communion and Reconciliation – if that is not the case, please contact the Parish Office.

If your child is not yet baptized, or if s/he was baptized in another Christian community (i.e. not in a Catholic church) please call the Church Office at 613-722-7661 so that suitable arrangements can be made. Consent of the parent/guardian is necessary and we need the time for the child to be prepared in the best way possible to be received into the Catholic Church.

Dates will be announced in September (or as soon as available thereafter). Please make sure to mark your calendar for the following events connected to the preparation of your child, all of which are **compulsory**: Information/ Registration Night (parent must attend), Enrolment Ceremony, Confession, Confirmation
